PRIMARY SECTION

At Little Angels' Primary school we hone the latent potential in your child recognize their various abilities and creativity. Encouraging academic learning in a superior and tranquil environment, supported by globally proven teaching methods it sets the foundation for literacy, numeracy and communication skills, Science, Information Technology and other fundamental skills are taught and practiced through cross circular work.

Little Angels' System believes on learning through doing. So our Junior Primary Wing offers an interactive style of teaching. The system is Eclectic which means a blend of few systems like Montessori, play-way, thematic and traditional put together. In the primary level our evaluation is based on Continuous Assessment System (CAS) and we do not assess the students with marks but letter grading.

- Small class size for effective and individual attention.
- Streamlined state of the art teaching methodologies that focus on child-centered teaching –learning environment.
- Emphasis on extracurricular activities like drama, sports, cultural events, and events that imbibe moral values is integrated into the curriculum.
- Each grade enjoys the attention of a team of highly trained teachers.
- Excellent administrators and caring teachers trained specially for primary level teaching.
- Coordination between teachers is done by class in-charges.
- Native English speakers are appointed to help our primary students strengthen their communicative English skills.

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LOWER SECONDARY AND SECONDARY SECTION

Students from grade VI to X are afforded a wide spectrum of knowledge which revolve around an extensive range of subjects and prepares them to excel in the Secondary Education Examination (SEE) conducted by the Nepal Government.

- The school has spacious, well-equipped libraries, well lit and ventilated, which houses books on varied subjects and encourages healthy reading habits.
- An ultra modern well-equipped laboratory for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, General Science provides excellent for augmenting classroom teaching.
- The most updated computer lab keeps our students abreast of the latest developments and offers a lot of scope to acquire hands on training and facilitates programming skills.
- A team of highly experienced teachers offer constant advice, guidance, and encouragement that create a stimulating academic environment.
- Encouraging a high level of performance. It is little wonder, thus, that our students have consistently excelled at all national level examinations.

CURRICULUM, EVALUATION, PROMOTION

The curriculum for different levels namely Basic Level Examination, Primary, Lower Secondary and Secondary are different, but integrated to form a continuum. It is revised and updated regularly by experts in consultation with the concerned level teachers and students. Our curriculum ensures that our students are well prepared for the Secondary Education Examination conducted by the government of Nepal. However, we do not limit ourselves to the government curriculum and include additional items so that our children acquire other necessary skills required for higher education. **Evaluation Programs/ Assessment Policy** Mainly our evaluation system for Grades I to III, we follow Integrated Curriculum (IC) and Continuous Assessment System (CAS). However, Grades IV to VIII is based on 50% Internal Assessment (IA): Unit Tests, Project Wroks, Book Review, Field Trip Report etc. and 50% External Evalaution (EE): Terminal and Annual Examinations. On the other hand for Grade IX is based on 25% Internal Assessment (IA): Unit Tests, Project Works, Book Review, Field Trip Report etc. and 75% External Evaluation (EE): Terminal and Annual Evaluation (EE): Terminal and Annual Evaluation (EE): Terminal and Annual Examinations.



- Dividing written examination into Unit Tests and Terminal Examinations.
- Spacing these examinations throughout the year.
- Providing project works, class assignments, and holiday homework on a regular basis and assigning marks to these activities.
- Assessing students' attitudes and behavior on regular basis, conducting a comprehensive evaluation every 3 months and interacting with parents on the progress of students.
- Taking into account the performance, attendance and other activities of the students throughout the year for final evaluation at the end of a session.



OUTDOOR EDUCATION/ RAISING ACHIEVEMENT, STUDENTS' AWARENESS PROGRAMS COMMUNITY LINKS:

We believe that much can be gained from 'on site visits' and each class teacher periodically will arrange school visits, which usually form an integral part of the children's work. A voluntary contribution is required to meet the costs of transport, insurance and entrance.

CRITERIA FOR PROMOTION

- Promotion will be decided on the whole year's performance and not merely on the basis of the final examination grades.
- The Principal/ Vice Principal, guided by the common code of fairness, can exercise his discretionary power for changing any of the condition mentioned above in exceptional cases, which cannot be quoted as a precedent

EVALUATION PROGRAMS/ASSESSMENT POLICY

Mainly our evaluation system for Grades I to III, we follow Integrated Curriculum (IC) and Continuous Assessment System (CAS). However, Grades IV to VIII is based on 50% Internal Assessment (IA): Unit Tests, Project Wroks, Book Review, Field Trip Report etc. and 50% External Evalaution (EE): Terminal and Annual Examinations. On the other hand for Grade IX is based on 25% Internal Assessment (IA): Unit Tests, Project Works, Book Review, Field Trip Report etc. and 75% External Evaluation (EE): Terminal and Annual Examinations.

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LIBRARY

LAS has big libraries with a wide selection of fiction and reference books relating to topics covered for each class. Children are taught the higher order reading skills so that the task of accessing information from reference material for research purposes is understood early on.

Children are encouraged to enjoy with books. They take books home to read. We have a home/ school reading policy.



EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

LAS, presents a broad and balanced atmosphere, recognizes the unique feature of each child and purses its goal of inspiring, allowing full scope for the development of personality. Various programs and activities beyond the curriculum are conducted and form an integral part of the curricular. Such activities go a long way in nurturing the creative potential of the students and making them into full rounded individuals.







Extra curricular activities are made an integral part of every student's life and include both indoor and outdoor activities. Facilities for football, cricket, basketball, volleyball, softball, lawn tennis and swimming are available within the school premises. Indoor facilities for table tennis and martial arts are also available.

The school organizes both inter-house and inter- school competitions for all these events to recognize champion and gear them up for inter school events under experts of national and international fame. It is, thus, no wonder that we have produced many a champions who have begged to top honors at almost all inter school events.

For those students who are more academically inclined, we organize a host of events including competitions in debating, elocution, extempore speech, music, singing, dance and one-act plays. These help in providing entertainment to the students as well as nurturing their talents.

- A robust thriving artsy theatre club showcases the talent of young actors.


SCHOOL DIARY

BOARDERS

- i. Parents / Guardians are permitted to visit their wards only on specified days as per the school calendar. Boarders may leave the school premises with approved escorts only.
- ii. Those going out for the weekend may be picked up from school after school between 4.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m.
- iii. All boarders must be back in the Hostel between 7.00am to 8.30am on the day school re-opens as mentioned in the School Calendar.
- iv. Visitors are not permitted inside the dormitories.
- v. Boarders are permitted to go home only on specified weekends.
- vi. The hostel remains closed during long vacations.



PRIVATE TUITION

- 1. Private tuitions are discouraged excepting in special cases.
- 2. Parents wishing to arrange private tuition for special cases should not approach teachers directly. A request application should be made to the Principal, Vice Principal, giving full details of their wards and reasons why they consider it necessary to arrange tuition.
- 3. No request for private tuition in Primary School will be entertained.
- 4. The Principal may amend these rules, if required, during the course of an academic year.



MEALS

There are three cafeterias in the school premises to serve hygienic cooked food to the students. For Day Meal, provision has been arranged for the students of Grades I to X. In the day meal Rice, Daal, Veg. Curry, Egg, Meat and Achar is served according to daily menu in the Dining Hall. Interested Parents / Guardians can enroll their wards' name through our Food Supervisor by filling the form on any school day. However, Grades I to V students are encouraged to bring food from home.

TRANSPORT

For school children transport arrangement is available from various parts of Kathmandu valley. A fleet consisting of 100+ buses ply over almost all main roads of the valley.



MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Round the clock medical assistance and the servicess of qualified medical professionals are available within the premises.



EDUCATIONAL VISITS

Educational visits are compulsory for the students of all grades and are organized on regular basis.

SEMINARS / WORKSHOPS / IN-HOUSE TRAINING/ TALK PROGRAM

Term wise SEMINARS / WORKSHOPS / IN-HOUSE TRAINING/ TALK PROGRAM are organized for the teachers.



WATER SUPPLY

Water from the deep well are collected and filtered by RO (River Osmosis) water filtration process and then supplied to the students for drinking. Sample of water is examined in the NAST Lab regularly.

RESIDENTIAL LIFE

Residential life at Little Angels' School is a world of vibrant robust activities. The life here is comfortable, well planned and tailor-made to suit young minds and promote healthy lives. It has elegant architecture, a picturesque backdrop of the Himalayas, well maintained, lush green gardens and an extremely tranquil environment.

Unlimited fun and a life of perfect harmony unfold in the residential complex where students experience a home away from home in an ambience that is friendly and hospitable matched with first-class facilities.

There are separate hostel blocks for juniors, boys and girls each with separate toilets, bathrooms and modern dining facilities. Clean and spacious dormitories, play grounds, state-of-the-art computer labs, common rooms, lawn tennis and badminton courts, football ground, a news and TV room, basketball court, gymnasium, table tenis and volley ball courts are some of the highlights of LAS' residential life.

FOOD AND WATER

The food and water facilities at Little Angels' School are under the supervision of trained professionals. So there is no compromise on the quality of food and water. A balanced diet of fresh food cooked under very hygienic conditions is served to the students where every palate enjoys the taste of different recipes.
